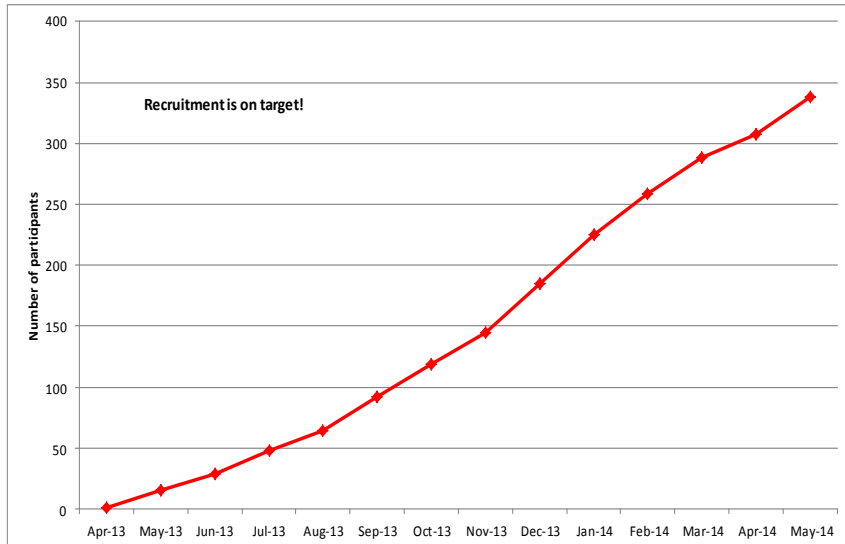

REMINDERS



- ✓ Remind the participants to complete their baseline questionnaires as soon as possible after the baseline visit and to post them to the trial office.
- ✓ Remind the participants to complete and post to trial office their follow-up questionnaires received in post.
- ✓ Always post consent/assent form in a separate envelope from the CRFs.
- ✓ Always post contact form (CRF 2) in separate envelope.
- ✓ DNA CRF form 8 is posted to the trial office with the rest of CRFs, i.e. it does not travel with the DNA sample.
