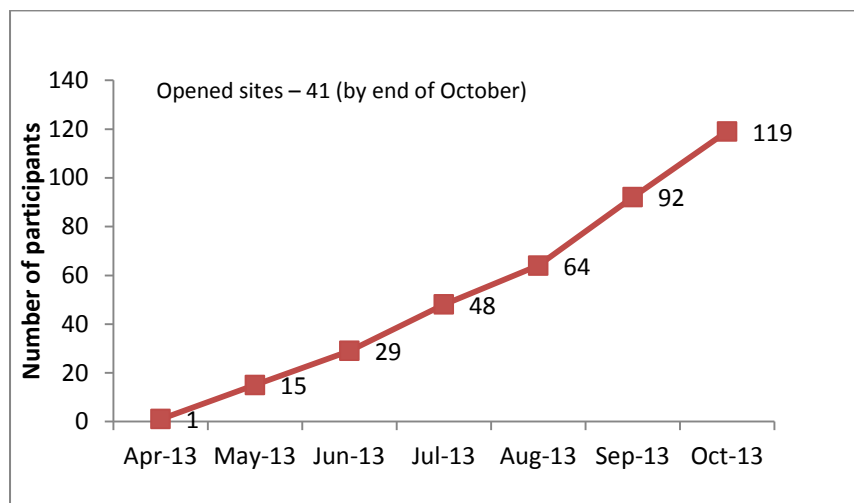

QUESTIONS



Can we recruit only to one Arm of the trial e.g. Arm B?

Yes.

Can we collect DNA sample after baseline visit?

DNA sample should be collected at baseline or at the first follow up visit preferably.

If patient had one Adverse Reaction, how do we submit the AR form?

You should keep the original AR form and post a photocopy to trial office. You should post a photocopy of the AR form every time it gets updated.

REMINDERS

- ✓ Consent forms should be INITIALLED not ticked.
- ✓ Blood/saliva tubes should be posted to trial office straight after they are collected.
- ✓ DO NOT write patient's name on the tubes. Use the template tube labels in **Section 13** of the ISF.
- ✓ DNA CRF form 8 should be posted to trial office using the brown A4 sized envelopes.
- ✓ Complete the header on the cover page of the baseline QoL with patient's randomisation number and initials before issuing to patient.
