

A pragmatic randomised controlled trial comparing the effectiveness and cost-effectiveness of Levetiracetam and Zonisamide versus standard treatments for epilepsy: a comparison of Standard And New Antiepileptic Drugs (SANAD-II)

QUALITY OF LIFE QUESTIONNAIRES

Please continue to issue a QoL booklet and SANADII envelope each time you see a patient in clinic. Site teams must complete the randomisation number at the top of the booklet along with the patient initials before issuing the booklet to pa-

There are four types of questionnaires; they contain different questions based on the age of/relationship to the patient.

Question-	Who should this booklet be issued to?
Adult	A patient who is 16+ regardless of the service they belong to
Parent	The parent of a child between ages between 5 and 15
Children	A patient between the ages of 8 and 11
Young Per-	A patient between the ages of 12 and 15

Once Arm B is analysed there will be an investigator meeting to disclose results prior to publication. This is expected to be in April 2019. Please register your interest

DNA SAMPLES

We have not received samples from all patients that have consented to have DNA collected as part of the study.

Please, check if you have collected DNA but forgotten to post it through to the central processing laboratory.



If a patient as consented to give a DNA sample but you have not collected it as yet, please do so ASAP.

If you require DNA collection supplies (blood collection or saliva kits), please contact the study team,

to you.

ARM A FOLLOW-

Please, don't forget that Arm A patients remain in follow-up until early July 2019! These patients should still be having annual followups for the SANAD2 trial until this point.

ARM B—DATA CLEANING AND **DATA LOCK**

As you know we are preparing to analyse the data for Arm B pa-



tients. During this process you will be sent a number of queries following on from our statistical checks. We do need to ensure all data is 'clean' before the database is locked and analysis can begin.

Thanks for your promptness in dealing with these queries—we don't want to delay data lock any further than necessary.
